Following the General Assembly of CEDEC on 24 June, Dr. Florian Bieberbach has been re-elected unanimously as Chairman of CEDEC, the European Federation of Local and Regional Energy Companies. Mr Bieberbach is CEO of Stadtwerke München (SWM) and Member of the Steering Group Energy of VKU (Verband kommunaler Unternehmen).

CEDEC Background information
