EUROPEAN COMMISSION: COMMUNICATION ON ENERGY UNION

The European Commission has adopted on **25 February** the Communication on the Energy Union. The Communication outlines a vision of the energy union which is built on 5 dimensions: 1. Energy security, solidarity and trust, 2. A fully integrated Internal Energy Market, 3. Energy efficiency as a contribution to the moderation of energy demand, 4. Decarbonisation of the economy,

5. Research and Innovation. Specific attention for citizens and local actors – as requested by CEDEC – through a 6th dimension or by integration in the 5 dimensions, is currently hardly to be found. CEDEC will continue to bring these messages across in the follow-up measures that will be taken.

EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT : ADOPTION OF THE DRAFT REPORT ON MARKET STABILITY RESERVE

The ENVI Committee at the European Parliament, has adopted, on 24 February, the report on the Commission proposal for / the establishment and operation of a market stability reserve (MSR) for the Union greenhouse gas emission trading scheme (ETS). With this vote, the ENVI Committee has adopted a report that improves the European Commission's proposal to some extent but stays below aspirations. While having preferred a permanent retire-

900 million -ment of the backloaded certificates. **CEDEC** welcomes the decision to directly transfer them into the reserve mechanism, as well as any unallocated certificates. However, having been advocating for an earlier start of the MSR in 2017, CEDEC considers the agreement for 31 December 2018 an insufficient compromise, even if it does improve on the initial date of 2021, proposed by the European Commission. THE FUTURE IS DISTRIBUTED: A DSO PERSPECTIVE

On 19 February, CEDEC co-organized a successful high-level event with representatives from the European DSO world gathered in Brussels: "The future is distributed: a DSO perspective". Their main message: the role of DSOs in the transition of Europe's energy system should be acknowledged. Regulation, policy and financing schemes should support

DSOs in fulfilling the energy transition objectives that the EU and national policy makers have set. The conference was co-organized by the four Brussels-based associations representing DSOs (CEDEC, EDSO for smart grids, EURELECTRIC and GEODE) and presented an open letter of joint recommendations to the incoming European Commission.
